

We are God's beloved, and God has chosen each of us as children of the Light, to be disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ. Nothing is to stand in the way of our commitment to respond and be active in God's will.

**FIRST READING** (*1 Kings 19:16b,19-21*) ~ The prophet Elijah symbolically carries out the Lord's command by throwing his cloak over his attendant and future successor, Elisha. This action indicates both God's choice and Elijah's surrendering, passing on his ministry. The young Elisha is met with a little harshness from the Prophet because he wants to say farewell to his family first. He severs all ties to lifestyle, family, and committing himself to God.

**SECOND READING** (*Galatians 5:1,13-18*) ~ Paul urges the Galatians not to be slaves to the letter of God's law, but to be led by the Spirit of God's law in their service to others. He reminds them that in Christ, we are set free from slavery to our own wants, in order to serve one another in love.

**GOSPEL** (*Luke 9:51-62*)  $\sim$  Jesus sends messengers ahead of himself as he resolutely sets out for Jerusalem, where he will



begin and accomplish his mission and ministry. Along the way, he is rejected, a foretaste of what things will be like in Jerusalem. But Jesus is not thwarted; he continues his journey. His firm, harsh words toward those wanting to follow him are not intended to discourage, but to emphasize the importance of total commitment.

We cannot allow ourselves to be discouraged from committing to the Lord's call. We cannot despair or give up. We need to persevere in telling the story of God's abundant grace by the loving and kind actions of our lives, and the encouraging words from our mouths.
