In Memory of Jesus

We celebrate today the **Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ**, also known by its Latin title, *Corpus Christi*. The Liturgical Mass we celebrate is the sacrifice of Christ and the banquet of his body and blood, the foretaste on earth of "What God has prepared for those who love him". (1Cor.2:9) at the heavenly "supper of the Lamb". (Rev. 19:9)

At the Last Supper, Jesus took bread, and then took wine, and invited his disciples into the prayer of thanksgiving to God. He blessed, broke and gave it to them, asking that they continue to "Do this in memory of me". The Eucharistic Prayer is led by Fr. Chrys, our Priest-President, and we are invited into Jesus' prayer of thanksgiving as a faith community. We believe and give thanks and praise to the Lord God and offer ourselves with full, conscious, active participation in the responses .


On this Feast Day, together with the Feast of the Holy Trinity last Sunday, we begin our Summer Ordinary Time. We take the opportunity on this most Blessed Feast of Corpus Christi to offer our humble thanks and praise, and to renew our faith, love, reverence, and adoration of the Eucharist, Jesus' loving gift of healing.

Celebrating Christ's Memorial

The Eucharist is the action of Christ and the faithful people of God. At the Last Supper with his disciples, Jesus Christ established the Eucharist and entrusted it to us – the Church – as a memorial of his saving passion and resurrection.

We gather as a faithful people in community, to offer our hearts full of thanks and praise to God. We celebrate the ancient and present memorial of the Lord's death and resurrection, and the promise of this saving grace for all.

As disciples of Christ, may we recognize the Lord, present to us not only on Sundays in the breaking of the bread, and the breaking open of The Word, but in each moment of life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Welcome & Thank You to Everyone for continuing to wear a mask (for the time being) when you come to celebrate Mass. Thank you for your conscientiousness and thoughtfulness. Your care and concern for others is appreciated by many! The general dispensation from Sunday Mass is lifted, and Parishioners & Friends are invited and encouraged to physically come back to church, gathering together again to worship God, pray and celebrate Eucharist at Mass.

We celebrate today the wondrous Feast of the Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ (Latin: "Corpus Christi"). The Liturgy reminds us of the mysteries celebrated, as we offer bread and wine around the altar table of the Lord. We thankfully remember Christ's sacrificial death for us, his nourishment for us through the Eucharist, and our unity with Jesus and one another as members of his body.

FIRST READING (Genesis 14:18-20) ~ King Melchizedek, a priest of God Most High, brought out bread and wine, and offered blessings to Abram from God Most High for success in defeating his enemies.

SECOND READING (1 Corinthians 11:23-26) ~ Paul shares and hands on the tradition he received: the remembrance of Jesus' blessed gift of his body and blood. He reminds the people that as often as they eat this bread and drink this cup, we proclaim the Lord's death and honor him until he comes again.

GOSPEL (Luke 9:11b-17) ~ At the late hour, as Jesus teaches the crowd of yearning people, the disciples urge him to send them home. Jesus challenges his disciples to feed the crowds, to which they respond they only have five loaves and two fish. Jesus takes the meager food, gives thanks to God, blesses, breaks and gives it to the people gathered. Through his actions, Jesus shows his apostles that there is no limit to what they can accomplish with his powerful Spirit within them. Christ offers the gathered crowd spiritual food, and from his abundance, there is still an abundance left over.

CTK Parish has a few Parishioners called to be members of the **Sick Visiting Ministry Team**. Their Ministry was restricted during the covid pandemic. It is now easing up again, and the Holy Eucharist, reserved in the tabernacle, may be taken (when requested), to those who are homebound or ill at home. This faithful action assures them that even though they are ill or unable to come to the church for Mass, they are still united, and connected with our Parish Family's faith and worship. They are indeed still members of the body of Christ, and held in heartfelt prayer.

***** FRAUDULENT EMAIL:** ~ Just a reminder to please be very conscious and aware of conniving **FRAUDULENT EMAILS**, (masquerading as priests/pastors, or people you know or are acquainted with), requesting money, or gift cards to be sent to them. **DO NOT ever send ANY money, nor gift cards, or anything.** Don't be tricked - these scammers are deceptively convincing. Always **DISCERN AND CONFIRM** verbally, if at all possible, with the friend/person 'supposedly' sending the email. Speak with them, or send a brand new separate email with the address you have on file. If you have no email address for them, **TOTALLY DISREGARD** the email! Be care-full and safe!

The consecrated bread we share at Mass is called "The Blessed Sacrament". It is the Body of Christ... the Most Holy Sacrament of the altar... the Sacrament Most Holy... the Sacrament Divine...the Bread of Life. It is reserved in the church's Tabernacle which, in our church, is in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel on the northwest corner.




Before going to our particular pew in the church, the gathering faith community is spiritually moved to consciously acknowledge the True Presence of Christ by facing the Most Holy Eucharist in the Tabernacle, and genuflecting, (bowing while bringing one knee to the ground), or by holding a posture of a profound bow.

As we reverently bow in the presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament, may we also remember to respect and reverence God's holy proclaimed Word (scripture), Holy Spirit within the temple hearts of one another as members of the Body of Christ, and indeed in all God's created people, and creation.
